Children must be at least six years old and accompanied by a registered adult.

### **ARTWORK GUIDELINES & INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **Grades 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> (GISD, private schools, homeschools)**

- The artwork must be done on paper and be no smaller than 8" x 10" and no larger than 16" x 24". Photographs are accepted. No frames on any of the artwork.
- Entries are accepted beginning January 2. The deadline for submitting entries is February 1.
- All entries must be submitted via email.
- You will be notified via email by Feb. 14 if your student's/child's work is chosen as a finalist in the contest. Packets with required paperwork for each finalist will be delivered on Feb. 15. Artwork and completed paperwork will be picked up on Feb. 24. At that time, all paperwork must be complete and submitted in order for the child's work to be considered in the next round. Winners will be notified on Mar. 13.
- Artwork will be judged by grade levels, arranged into 2 categories: 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> grades, 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING ENTRIES**

Please follow these instructions to submit your student's/child's bird or nature-related art on paper.

Submit a photo of your student's or child's artwork. Take a photo of your student's/child's artwork and upload it to your computer. Save and title the file: Student's LastName\_FirstName\_Grade. Email the file to [artentry@gintc.org](mailto:artentry@gintc.org). If you take the photo with your cell phone and have the ability to email it via your phone, you still must include the child's name and grade.

Should your student or child be chosen as a finalist,  
a complete application will be required, along with a signed waiver and photo release.
